
The Concert Truck

Returning to Norfolk this May, **The Concert Truck** is a mobile music venue that strengthens communities by redefining the concert experience and making music accessible to all. Impassioned by their love for music and belief in its emotional power, pianists Nick Luby and Susan Zhang converted a 16-foot box truck into a fully functioning mobile concert hall, complete with lights, sound system, and piano. Since then, The Concert Truck has presented free concerts across the country in city streets, music and arts festivals, schools, neighborhoods, parks...anywhere you can think to park a truck.
