After a gorgeous and festive Thursday evening at Chrysler Museum and Glass Studio, Friday night kept the energy up at outdoor venues along Granby Street until moving inside to keep rocking out of the rain. Our myriad artists and performers didn't skip a beat, and all the local businesses looked packed with festival goers. All around the district both nights, you could see the smiling faces and know everyone was feeling the glow. Beyond that, a few numbers also show just how much space NEON Festival creates for the arts:

- 6,000 visitors over two days
- 500 creatives performing, showing or making
- 140 professional and student artists' work on view
- 97 programs and performances
- 34 community partners
- 6 public art projects
- 20 venues
- 3 pop up galleries

It's just not possible to create this kind impact without dozens of committee members, staff and volunteers. Our deepest thanks goes out to those who donated their time and spirit into creating the 8th Annual NEON Festival. Neighborhood News

Live since 2022, the City of Norfolk's Commercial Corridor Program is available to revitalize and grow the city's main streets and neighborhoods by addressing specific areas and their needs and assisting small businesses with commercial real estate technical assistance. The program includes funding through the Façade Improvement Grant which provides capital to eligible small businesses and property owners for renovations and upgrades. The first round focused on Park Place and Riverview, but the second round has expanded to other areas like the NEON District.
