

# May 2024 Newsletter

The NEON District in Norfolk is set to undergo a transformation with the launch of the NEON District Streetscape Project, beginning mid-June. The project encompasses a comprehensive overhaul of infrastructure and placemaking enhancements along Granby Street from Brambleton Avenue to Virginia Beach Boulevard.

Key project features include;

- Reconstruct the roadway, sidewalks and curbs
- Add ADA-compliant ramps and painted crosswalks
- · Update traffic signals and add pedestrian signal heads and buttons
- Replace water and sewer system
- Upgrade stormwater collection and add a conveyance system to improve drainage
- · Introduce a biofiltration system to address water quality
- Modernize utility lines with underground electrical conduits providing electrical service directly to properties
- Install street lighting with new lamp posts
- · Improve landscaping with tree canopy and planter boxes

Add new amenities including seating and electric vehicle (EV) charging stations

The NEON District Streetscape Project will take two to three years to complete. Initially, the project will focus on infrastructure improvements in the 700 block of Granby Street. During construction, vehicular traffic will be restricted to northbound travel (towards Virginia Beach Boulevard) and there will be no on-street parking in the 700 block, but additional parking is being added along Virginia Beach Boulevard and Monticello Avenue. Throughout construction, pedestrian access to businesses will be maintained through wooden walkways with signage to direct visitors.

Upon completion of the \$10.6M project, the NEON District will feel more like a natural extension of Downtown while retaining its own unique identity. From the vibrant art to the green tree canopy, every aspect will reflect the investments of the past and encourage the creativity of the future.
