

For the first time, we are inviting producers to design and implement your own programming under the NEON Festival umbrella. We will provide the venue, a production grant and festival support, if you can bring the energy.

How it works:

- Submit an event proposal for a neighborhood space or venue, with a budget, scope of work and programming ideas
- The festival planning committee will select 5-8 producers and match them with available spaces for Friday, 10/18, 6-10pm
- Each producer will receive a grant from \$500-\$5000 to cover event related expenses
- Planning and production will take place August-October

Have talent but don't want to steer the ship? Community partners, artists and performers are encouraged to join a creative roster which will be shared with festival producers. If there is a good match, we'll make the introduction. Sign up now!

The request for proposals and creative roster registration are available now until 11:59pm on Sunday, August 11, 2024. All applicants will be notified of invitation to participate by August 19, 2024. Questions can be directed to info@neonnfk.com.
