The NEON District is seeking an artist or artist team to complete a dynamic, large-scale mural before this year's NEON Festival, on October 17 and 18, 2024. Adjacent to the 2016 mural 757 *Energy & Vibe* by Jerrod Ray on WTKR property in the NEON District, the project offers the opportunity to collaborate with both the property owner, local television studio WTKR, and PRA Group, the presenting sponsor.

The project comes with a \$4,000 stipend for design, time, materials and travel expenses. The open call is now live and will close Wednesday, September 18, 2024 at 11:59pm. Get Fired Up

After months of construction, the new wing of the Perry Glass Studio opens to the public this September. The original portion of the space will remain closed as Chrysler teams transition into the new 18,000-square-foot space (and new address at 245 Grace Street) with regular programming once again. Pumpkinpalooza, Glass After Dark and the Visiting Artist Series will heat up the new amphitheater and hot shop full of state-of-the-art equipment and later this fall, the NEON Festival will have a whole new vibe at the Studio on Thursday, October 17. Expect new programming in different spaces as the night shifts entirely to the Studio. Expect a grand opening in spring 2025 when both sides of the expansion and renovation are complete.
